Lastly, we want to reiterate a few key dates and aspects which were announced during the State of the School and shared via email last week, as they pertain to the upcoming school year:

- In the 2020-2021 school year, Westerly plans to offer BOTH oncampus and online learning in parallel. This means you will be able to choose which means of accessing Westerly is right for your family's unique situation.
- Our new school year is planned to begin on August 17 and 19. Kinder-4th Grade students would begin on the earlier date, while Grades 5 through 8 would begin on the latter. We also outline alternative dates in the presentation slides in case an August return isn't possible due to health restrictions.
