Recreational reading is one of the most effective ways to develop verbal skills which help to ensure a student's success in school. The fifth grade summer reading program will foster these skills and ease the transition from summer back into school.

Prior to beginning fifth grade in the fall, students are required to read at least two books. They should be prepared to discuss the book's characters, main events and theme during the first week of school. I am attaching a list of grade appropriate books if your child would like to choose a book from here. I am always looking for new books to share with students.

Another important skill in math will be having their addition and subtraction math facts and times tables memorized.
