

Full Program Overview

Summer with Westerly engages students all summer long through a dynamic range of enrichment experiences that focus on the whole child. *Summer with Westerly* is dedicated to giving campers a well-rounded summer experience embracing their passions and encouraging the pursuit of new experiences. We believe in providing a space that fosters intellectual curiosity through hands-on classes in the sciences, engineering and arts, while promoting healthy movement and play with sports, team building games, water days and more! Programs vary by grade level. Our full day camp is geared towards children going into grades Kindergarten through 8th grade, with a half day program option for Pre-Kindergarten ages.



Westerly's Pre-K and Kindergarten Summer program allows participants to experience and prepare for classroom routines and expectations through songs, read-alouds, arts and crafts and more! Campers will explore different countries and habitats as they take trips to locations around the world discovering about the culture, history, and habitats of each unique place.



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1st-5th Summer Specialty Courses: Expanding Horizons

Details

Summer with Westerly Expanding Horizons for grade levels 1st–5th allows participants to explore multiple creative specialty courses in disciplines of Science/Engineering, Arts, and Technology each week. Groups spend each day rotating through 3 different specialty courses where they dive deep into hands-on projects and activities. Engineering, Acting & Movement Skills, Becoming an Archaeologist, Computer Programming & Design, Painting & Sketching, Graphic Design, and more.



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Middle School 6th-8th Description

Details

Summer with Westerly Middle School program allows campers to focus in on a single specialty subject and hone in on the area of specialty, which engages campers in an ongoing project or skill. Middle school courses take place over a two week theme, however you are able to register for individual weeks.



Sessions 1 & 2: Digital Arts

Explore photography, film-making, graphic design and digital illustration in this introductory course in Digital Arts.

Sessions 3 & 4: Create-gineering

From balloon rockets to giant pendulums, this engaging and innovative course integrates Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts & Math. The daily challenges and activities will give students opportunities to create, build, and problem solve in a collaborative community.



Sessions 5 & 6: Farm-to-Table Cooking

In this hands-on course, we will plant and cultivate crops in the Westerly Garden then harvest food to create healthy and delicious meals. Learn basic cooking techniques and ingredient preparation in the kitchen while also practicing organic gardening and sustainability.

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Extended Care

Details

Summer with Westerly offers extended care hours after our main programming from 3:30pm–6:00pm. Extended hours are an additional flat rate of \$100 per session for the week of after care. Campers are supervised with campers choice indoor or outdoor activities (examples, board games, coloring, playground equipment, books, blocks).

*Please note that extended hours are not offered for Pre-K campers.

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
